Rules and Regulations

Cornerstone Trinity Baptist Church

Basketball Tournament

General rules - All Divisions

1. If a player participates under an assumed name or if a team enters and plays an ineligible player, there will be an automatic forfeit and suspension for the team from further Cornerstone Trinity Baptist Church Tournaments, leagues, and/or associated events.
2. Only players of Asian or Pacific Islander descent are eligible to participate.
3. A valid picture I.D. and birth certificate will be requested if eligibility is questioned. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee are final.
4. Grace period: Ten minutes. Team will forfeit if players do not arrive within the allotted time frame.
5. Trash talking, fighting, and swearing will not be tolerated. The conduct of players and supporting spectators is the sole responsibility of the respective team's coach. Any misconduct by team members may result in disqualification at the discretion of the referees or tournament committee.

Game rules

1. Pool Bracket Tiebreakers (if applicable): A. Win-Loss Record B. Least total points allowed C. Free Throws: Best of 5 with 5 different players. Best of 5 will continue until a winner is determined.
2. Time Outs: Three full timeouts and two 30-second timeouts per game, per team. One additional full timeout per overtime period.

A+ Division

1. NCAA Rules - no shot clock.
2. Two 20-minute full stop-time halves. Clock stops on all whistles.
3. Overtime: First OT: 5-minutes full stop-time, full stop-time during last 2 minutes. Second OT: 2 minutes full stop-time. Third OT: Sudden Death (first team to score one or more points)

A MAJOR and Women's Divisions

1. NCAA Rules - no shot clock.
2. Two 20-minute semi-stop time halves. Clock only stops on free throws and timeouts. Stop time in the last minute of the first half; last two minutes of the second half.
3. Overtime: First OT: 5-minutes semi-stop time, full stop-time during last 2 minutes. Second OT: 2 minutes full stop-time. Third OT: Sudden Death (first team to score one or more points)

High School Divisions

1. No shot clock.
2. All teams are guaranteed 3 games.
3. Four 8-minute stop-time quarters. Clock stops on all whistles.
4. Overtime: First OT: 5-minutes running time, full stop-time during last 2 minutes. Second OT: 2 minutes full stop-time. Third OT: Sudden Death (first team to score one or more points)
